He worked for Kayafas Architects for over 10 years.

Tim worked for 2 years as the Director of Design and Construction for Century Equities, a real estate investment and development firm, gaining valuable experience in real estate acquisitions and construction projects on the east coast. Responsibilities included new building & development designs, overseeing renovations, & performing building inspections.
